What is Stick it to Cancer?

'Stick it to Cancer' (SITC) is a fun hockey tournament designed to raise funds for the Maggie's Cancer Centre in Edinburgh. SITC will offer hockey teams the opportunity to participate in a Round Robin tournament. Teams are encouraged to dress as a super heroes and villains to unite in the fight against cancer. Prizes will be awarded to the Best Dressed and Winning Teams. A BBQ, Bake Sale and Raffle offering the chance to win fantastic prizes will be available too.

When is it?

Sunday 9th June. Registration is 9.00 – 9.30am with the first fixture starting at 10.00am. The tournament will finish at approx. 4pm.

Where is it?

The hockey tournament will be at Edinburgh Academy's Hockey pitches on East Fettes Avenue.

Who can play?

Players must be Under 14 at 1st Jan 2019. 8-a-side mixed teams with a maximum squad of 12 players.

How much does it cost?

Each participant is asked to pay a donation of £10. Please let us know how you intend on paying using the Registration form. There are three options for payment:

U14 STICK IT TO CANCER – HOCKEY FESTIVAL RULES

1. Players must be Under 14 at 1st Jan 2019. 8-a-side mixed teams with a maximum squad of 12 players. Please note a minimum of three female players must be on the pitch at all times.

2A. NO CORNERS. A free hit will be taken from 5 metres outside the edge of the circle. Team on offense: The ball must go 5 metres before taking a shot on goal. Player can go 5 meters by either dribbling or passing to teammate.

2B. Long corners will be taken from the side line.

3. Goalkeepers - If a team does not have a goalkeeper, they have 2 options

A. They can play with a kicking back. The kicking back must wear a shirt of a colour different from either team.

B. If the team you are playing against agrees prior to the start of the game, you may pick-up a goalkeeper from another team.

4. Umpires are responsible for providing scores to the pitch manager. The score sheets must be verified by both teams and returned to Top Desk.

5. Standings will be determined using the following point system:

- ✓ 3 points for a win
- ✓ 1 point for a tie
- ✓ 0 points for a loss

6. Protests regarding umpire decisions are not allowed. Questions or concerns about all other aspects of the tournament shall be brought to the Top Desk and will be addressed/resolved.

7. If two or more teams are tied for determining standings, the determining factors will be as follows:

- A. The result of the match between the tied teams (Head to Head)
- B. Fewest goals conceded
- C. Most goals scored.

If teams remain tied, seeding will be determined by penalty strokes. Each team will be allowed 3 players for strokes.

8. Each team is responsible for nominating an umpire to officiate a few games on the day.

9. The ball must be played below waist height. Only when 1 on 1 with a keeper can the ball be raised at goal.

10. This is a fun tournament! We encourage all players and spectators to participate fully and be respectful towards umpires and event staff.
